

# Arduaine Garden for schools

Arduaine Garden is an outstanding 20-acre garden situated on a promontory off the Sound of Jura. Favoured by the Gulf Stream, it is nationally noted for rhododendrons, azaleas, magnolias and other interesting trees and shrubs. The garden also has a series of ponds and watercourses, and perennials flowering throughout the season. There are many fine crosses and standing stones within a few miles.

- preparation: we welcome a free preparatory visit by the teacher
