

Inveresk Lodge Garden for schools

Inveresk Lodge Garden is an attractive terraced garden surrounding a 17th-century lodge (the lodge is not open to the public). The garden displays a range of plants for the small garden, with a good shrub-rose border, a herb garden, a selection of climbing roses and an attractive display of autumn colour. A pond and a mixed woodland area complement the formal garden around the house.

● education programme

Inveresk Lodge Gardens is an important primary resource that offers cross-curricular learning opportunities for key areas of the 5-14 Curriculum
a site visit offers

- A teaching pack and resource box is available to allow teacher-led studies in the grounds including topics such as keys, minibeasts and pond-dipping
- special tour by the gardener or ranger (allow at least 1 hour)

classroom resources

- information relating to activities for the classroom is included in the teacher's pack

● practical information

planning your visit

- pre-booking is essential
- maximum class size: 30 with a ratio of 1 teacher/adult to 10 children
- cost for school parties: children £1 - accompanying adults admitted free of charge
- Educational Membership of the National Trust for Scotland allows free entry to all NTS properties
- preparation: we welcome a free preparatory visit by the teacher

during your visit

- visiting teachers are responsible for discipline
- children are encouraged to wander freely but must keep to the paths
- on arrival: please report to the garden entrance to book in with Garden Guide
- picnic facilities: an area is available, without seating
- toilets: available at the property
